Editorial & RWBTFC News

Welcome to Highworth Town

A warm welcome to the players, officials and spectators from Highworth Town for this Wiltshire Senior Cup Quarter-Final tie. We hope all those from Highworth who have made the short journey enjoy their stay with us this evening and we wish them a safe journey home.

Tonight is our 20th home game of the season with Christmas still a couple of weeks away but you can't blame the fixture scheduling this season for so many home games in the first part of the season as by the time we play Ascot on Saturday we will have played 12 at home and 11 away in the league. Amazingly we have had eight home draws in cup competitions so far this season, three in both this competition and the FA Vase, one in the FA Cup and one in the Floodlit Cup. With another home tie in the Bluefin Insurance Cup in the New Year I cannot remember a season when we have been lucky enough to be the first out of the hat, bag or bucket used for the draws. Long may it continue although we have been drawn away in the Floodlit Cup, where we will again meet tonight's opponents in the New Year.

Highworth have made it through to this round of the competition having defeated Downton 2-1 at Downton and then were awarded their scheduled Second Round tie when Laverstock & Ford were unable to raise a team. Our passage to this stage came courtesy of home wins against two Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League sides, Cricklade Town and Trowbridge Town. Surprisingly this is only the third meeting between the two sides in this prestigious competition, the two previous meetings being in Season 1994-95 and Season 1995-96.

In 1994-95, when the two sides met for the first time in the competition, Highworth were already a Hellenic Premier League side whilst we were still in Division One. Highworth raced into a 2-0 lead but goals from Wayne Glastonbury and Scott Vincent brought us back into the game and take the game into extra-time. Bassett fell behind again early in the extra half hour, however the dependable Kevin Moloney equalised from the spot before adding the winner in the last minute, capitalising on a fumbled cross to take Bassett through.

In 1995-96 the two sides met in the semi-final and it again took extra time to decide the tie. The report in the Evening Advertiser noted that Bassett had the better of the first half in which Highworth lost Kevin Tucker with a broken nose and Darren Hale with a leg injury. Bassett defender Neil Timbrell gave us the lead in the 61st minute, crashing in a 25-yarder following a corner on the right. Highworth fought back and equalised in the closing stages of the game, sub Paul Donnolly scoring with a diving header to take the game into extra time. Four minutes into the second period Steve Tucker put Highworth in front from 20 yards and almost on time Paul O'Driscoll made sure of victory, tapping in a good cross from the right. So the it is 1-1 in this competition with both games having gone into extra-time, what odds extra time being needed again tonight to decide this tie?

Highworth have made a superb start to the season with 19 wins in their opening 22 league fixtures and just one defeat against Wantage Town. They currently sit some 10 points ahead of second placed Thatcham Town with Thatcham having one game in hand. On current form Highworth are odds on favourites to take promotion to the Southern League and also win the Uhlsport Hellenic League title. That said they still have some tough fixtures with both Bracknell and Windsor to play twice and a return game with Thatcham, who they have beat 2-1 at Thatcham back in October, so no doubt manager Jeff Roberts will make sure they remain focused until they are mathematically over the line. We also may cause an upset in our upcoming Boxing Day fixture, as many neutrals have said we were the better side on the day until we pressed the self-destruct button when we lost to Highworth back on August Bank Holiday. What we do know is that tonight will be a very tough fixture, but I am sure the lads will be keen to get through to the semi-finals and the prospect of a possible tie against Chippenham Town (managed by Sam Collier's dad) or Salisbury (managed by Steve Claridge). The other quarter-final ties in this competition saw Bremhill from the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League play Bemerton Heath Harlequins last night, whilst this evening Chippenham Town host Chippenham Park and Salisbury travel to Westbury United, all games obviously subject to the weather given the snow at the weekend.

Binfield picked up an excellent 2-1 win at Brimscombe & Thrupp, never an easy place to go as we found earlier in the season. Tuffley Rovers continued their winning run with a 2-0 away success at Burnham. In the other game played in the Premier Division, improving Ascot United defeated Fairford 4-2 ahead of our visit their next Saturday. They have won their last two games and will be tough opponents on Saturday. Hopefully we will make it three wins on the bounce from our visits to Ascot.



Opponents - History

Highworth Town • Club History

Highworth Town Football Club was formed in 1893. They joined the Cirencester & District League and it took them some time to record their first honours, until 1909-10 in fact, when they won both the Swindon Junior Cup and the local Advertiser Cup, a cup they were to capture again in 1912-13.

After winning the Cirencester & District League Division Two Championship in 1931-32, Highworth moved to the Swindon & District League, where they completed the Third Division Championship and Swindon Junior Cup double in 1933-34.

The 1950s saw Highworth make a dramatic rise through the local football ranks. They won the Swindon & District League Third Division title again in 1954-55 and then the Division Two title the following season. One more season was needed to clinch the Division One title and also the Wilts Junior Cup. They then went on to win the Premier Division title in 1957-58, along with the Faringdon Thursday Memorial Cup and the following season saw them Premier Champions again, also winning the Advertiser Cup.

Highworth continued to dominate the Swindon & District Premier Division in the 1960s, winning four successive titles from 1960-61 and another hat-trick from 1965-66 to 1967-68, making seven titles in eight seasons. They reached the final of the Wilts Senior Cup for the first time in 1962-63 and won it the following season.

There was a switch to the Wilts Combination League, where they finished as Runners-Up in Division Two in 1970-71. 1972-73 saw another Wilts Senior Cup victory and all this success prompted them to join the Hellenic League. They achieved their first honours in 1988-89, winning the First Division Challenge Cup and reached the final of the Wilts Senior Cup yet again.

They finally achieved Premier Division status in 1993-94 gaining promotion after finishing third in Division One. Since then they have been Winners of the Wilts Senior Cup in 1995-96, 1997-98, 2008-09 and again in 2014-15 , Winners of the Hellenic League Challenge Cup in 2011-12, Winners of the Hellenic League Supplementary Cup in 1998-99 and Runners-Up in 2003-04, Runners-Up in the Premier Division in 1999-2000 and Winners of the Premiership Title in 2004-05.

However, their greatest achievement to date was in reaching the Semi-Final of the FA Vase in 2015, where they were knocked out by eventual winners, North Shields in a closely fought two-legged tie.







"A goal from Lee Stoddart after seven minutes and a penalty from Paul Harper three minutes later gave Wootton Bassett a Wilts Senior Cup Final victory over Shrewton United by 2-0. Shrewton tried hard to get on terms in the second half but the woodwork and some excellent keeping by Richard Stevens prevented them from scoring."

Elsewhere in the non-league scene the Hellenic Premier Division was won by Swindon Supermarine who finished twelve points clear of runners-up Brackley Town. Carterton Town won the Challenge Cup and Swindon Supermarine won the Floodlit Cup for the second consecutive season.

Meanwhile in the Wiltshire League, the Premier Division was won by Cricklade Town with Shrewton United runners-up. The Intermediate Division champions were Wanborough United, with Blunsdon United runners-up. Ashton Keynes were crowned Junior Division 1 champions with Wroughton Reserves finishing as runners-up. Junior Division 2 was won by Swindon Eagles with Wootton Bassett United runners-up.

Cricklade Town finally won the Addkey Senior KO Cup the second consecutive season defeating Devizes Town Reserves in the final. Swindon Eagles defeated Wootton Bassett United in the final of the Fountain Trophies Junior Cup.

Elsewhere, in the Swindon & District League the Premier Division champions were County Ground. Division One champions were Fusion Coleview and Division Two was won by Moredon Gulag. Queenstown lifted the Division 3 title. The Advertiser Cup was won by Liden whilst the George Thomas Cup was won by Queenstown.

In the world of professional football, Manchester United win the league finishing ten points clear of second placed Arsenal. The Gunners also suffer the agony of losing the FA Cup Final, going down 2-1 against Liverpool. The Anfield team, meanwhile, completed a unique treble, also adding the League Cup and UEFA Cup titles. Leeds United reach the Champions League semi-finals, while Swindon Town finish 20th in the third tier of English football, avoiding relegation by just one point.

Hellenic Years - 2000-2001

As this is the 30th year of our participation in the Hellenic League this year's programme will look back at each of those years to see what was going on in the local Non-League football at the time.

Today the featured season is 2000-2001:

It was great timing that the first full season of the new Millennium coincided with the dawning of a new era for Wootton Bassett Town as they were set to take their bow at Hellenic Premier Division

There was certainly a buzz of excitement within the club heading into the campaign - and justifiably so - as evidenced by the following report published in the Evening Advertiser's non league season preview on Thursday 17th August 2000:

"Wootton Bassett Town, who finished in third place in Division One last season, have been promoted to the Premier Division and are facing a tough task. During the close season the club has installed floodlights and seating to a small stand. Secretary Rod Carter said: "The seats came from the County Ground at Stratton Bank end. "The new floodlights were a self-financing venture with help from the Football Association and grants from other organisations. We have a new hospitality room and PA system and we are raring to go."

Manager Barry Giles said: "All of last season's squad has resigned and new faces to the squad will include Ben Parsons from Purton, Phil Penning from Calne Town, Paul Patel from Highworth and Jason Edwards and Daryl Simms from Swindon Supermarine. "Former manager of Pewsey Vale Tony Lockyear is club coach together with Mick Byrne. It is going to be a tough season for us but if prolific scorers from last season Lee Stoddart and Paul Harper find the net regularly hopefully we will be able to compete with the senior sides in the section."

Barry Giles' team, however, would receive a rude awakening in their opener against local rivals Fairford Town, who romped to a 6-0 victory. Bassett were competitive for the opening twenty minutes or so, but two goals before the break from their hosts crushed any confidence as the side fell victim to an attacking masterclass. The team would go on to finish a creditable 13th in the Premier Division in their first season. However, the main success for the season would come in the Wiltshire Senior Cup. Two goals from Nathan Hall had set them on the way in a 6-0 home win over Amesbury Town. Further goals from Lee Marshall, Richard Merchant, Lee Stoddart and Mickey Goodwin completing the scoring. In the Second Round local rivals Purton were knocked out at Rylands Way, goals from Lee Stoddart (2) Jon Davis and Paul Davis in the 4-1 win. This set up a semi-final with Cricklade Town and Bassett edged through 2-1 thanks to a Mickey Goodwin strike and an own goal to set up a final with Shrewton. Staged at Melksham's The Conigre Bassett tasted success in the oldest knockout contest in Wiltshire for only the second time. The Saturday May 5th 2001 edition of the Evening Advertiser carried the following round up of the match:

- Royal Wootton Bassett Town and Highworth Town have met each other 66 times with our visitors certainly having the better of things, winning 33 games to 24 for Wootton Bassett, 8 games having been drawn.
- The first fixture we have been able to trace was back in 1898 when the two sides met in a friendly on 8th January 1898 which Wootton Bassett Town won 3-2.
- The first league encounter came in the Vale of White Horse League with Highworth winning that one 2-0 and also winning the return game in Wootton Bassett.
- The two sides have met in 5 different leagues over the years. As well as the Vale of White Horse League the sides have met in the Swindon & District League, Wiltshire Combination, Wiltshire County league and the Hellenic League.
- Despite the first encounter being in the 1800's there were very few meetings between the two sides until the 1970's when Highworth joined the Wiltshire Combination where Wootton Bassett were already playing.
- A famous goal scorer for Wootton Bassett Town in the game at Highworth on 27th October 1973 was a one Bob Anderson later to become World Darts champion in 1988 and the first man to win the World Darts Masters three times running. Unfortunately his goal was a consolation goal as Highworth beat us 3-1 that day.
- On 15th November 1975 a 16-year-old Gary Dixon fired a hat-trick at Ryalnds Way in a 3-1 win over Highworth. Dixon would go on to be Bassett's top player of the late 1970's early 1980's. A certain Steve Slattery, later to be the England physio, scored the consolation goal for Highworth.
- The first ever cup meeting between the two sides came in the FA Amateur cup way back in 1964-65 when Wootton Bassett won 8-1 away, Dave Challis scored four, Andy Harkness and Bill Stevens both bagging a brace. This represents our biggest ever win over Highworth.
- Highworth's best result is much more recent when two seasons back they hammered us 8-0 at the Elms in a Christmas Holiday fixture.
- Both teams joined the Hellenic League from the Wiltshire County League but interesting to note that Highworth were not promoted out of the Wiltshire League. They joined the Hellenic in 1984-85 at a time when it was not necessary to win promotion, having finished in 10th place in the Wiltshire County League in 1983-84. Wootton Bassett moved up to the Hellenic at the end of 1987-88 having won promotion as champions of the Wiltshire County League.
- Highworth have certainly performed better than Bassett since joining the Hellenic League having won the Premier Division in 2004-05, winning the title at Rylands Way on a day we were relegated and also finishing runners-up in 1999-2000. They have also won the Challenge Cup in 2011-12.
- Wootton Bassett Town have met Highworth Town three times in the FA Cup with Bassett yet to lose a fixture.
- Three members of the current squad have scored against Highworth, Steve Yeardley, Sam Packer and Callum Wright.

Player Profile

Gio Wrona (Midfield)



Wrona, a classy midfield operator, joins the club this season and boasts Southern League experience. Two-footed, with a great passing range and plenty of skill, he is capable of playing anywhere across the midfield line, though is most effective in a central role where he is capable of dictating a game.

Initially a New College graduate, Wrona has also featured for Swindon Supermarine, Thatcham Town, Larkhall Athletic, Devizes Town, Wantage Town, North Leigh and Cricklade Town during his career.

Wrona remained was with the student side in their inaugural Hellenic League Division One West campaign in 2011-12. And the attacking midfielder was their standout player that season, winning the team's Player of the Year award while scoring sixteen times in 35 appearances. Among his haul was a goal in New College's 5-2 win over Bassett at Rylands Way and a hat-trick away at Headington Amateurs.

Wrona added two goals in nine appearances for New College in the early months of the following campaign before briefly moving to Carterton. He spent the majority of the campaign with Devizes Town, scoring four times in 26 games for a side who would ultimately wind up bottom of Western League Division One.

The midfielder began the 2013-14 campaign with Swindon Supermarine, appearing six times from the bench for them. From there he moved back to Devizes before transferring to Thatcham Town, who were then plying their trade in the Southern League.

He began the 2014-15 season back with Supermarine, while also featuring on a dual-registration with Shrivenham. In November of that year he transferred to Southern League Larkhall Athletic, where he made thirty appearances.

After beginning the subsequent season with the Bath-based club, Wrona spent the majority of the 2015-16 campaign with Wantage Town.

Last season Wrona plied his trade primarily with Cricklade in the Wiltshire League, and featured sparingly for North Leigh too. With Cricklade, he re-found his scoring form, netting twelve times in 29 games.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town FC • Club History

Situated in the small market town six miles west of Swindon, Royal Wootton Bassett Town Football Club was first established within the town in 1882, making the club one of the oldest in the county of Wiltshire. The club's early achievements came in the prestigious Wiltshire Senior Cup, making the final in both 1902-3 and 1903-4, although both ended in defeat. Wootton Bassett Town F.C. folded for a period pre World War 1 before re-forming in the Calne & District League when the club began playing at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground which had been donated by local dignitary Major Gerard Buxton for sporting activities within the town and opened in 1930.

Early successes included winning the Calne & District League in the 1930-31 Season, having finished runners-up the previous season, and then again in 1934-35. Following a move up to the Wiltshire League Division 2 promotion was earned again the following season and the team then remained in the top division in the county until the outbreak of war.

After the war Wootton Bassett Town F.C. recommenced in the County Senior League with limited success until Season 1958-59 when they won their first Wiltshire League title. In 1987-88 the Wiltshire League Division 1 title was won, elevating the Club into the Hellenic League, where they have remained ever since. Season 1987-88 also saw the club again reach the final of the Wiltshire Senior Cup but that first win remained elusive. That changed in 1998-99, however, when the Club defeated Pewsey Vale 3-2 in the final at the County Ground and success was again achieved in Season 2000-01 when Shrewton were defeated 2-0 in the final. The First Team, having finished runners-up in Division One West in Season 2012-13, currently play in the Premier Division of the Hellenic League, at Step 5 of the Football Pyramid.

As well as the First Team the Club has always run an adult Development/Reserve team. Since the onset of the new millennium the club has also expanded significantly, with the establishment of a large thriving Youth Section and a very successful Ladies Section. The Ladies side recently did the "double" of being cup winners and securing promotion in the same season. The latest addition to the Club has been the establishment of a Veterans team, so the club now operates 26 teams from under 7s upwards. This growth led to the club being awarded Charter Standard Development Club status by the Football Association in 2008 before this was upgraded to Community Club status a year later. Wootton Bassett Town F.C. was the first club in Wiltshire to achieve this. International ties have also been established, with three Youth Section teams touring Holland annually since 2001. This has led to a relationship with amateur side FC 's-Gravenzande, who are based near The Hague.

The club now play their games at the fantastic New Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, which was opened in the summer of 2015 and with the Royal title now included within the club name, the Club continues to thrive as a key part of the community of Royal Wootton Bassett. Season 2017-18 again sees Rich Hunter in charge of the First Team as the Club looks to better its highest ever position in Non-League football the 11th place finish achieved in Season 2014-15. The Club will again be entering the F.A. Cup and F.A. Vase with the Development side playing in the Wiltshire County League.

From the Archives...

Five star Bassett give Highworth a hiding

The Elms, 17th March 2015

Nathan Gambling scored a second half hat-trick as a rampant team display delivered Wootton Bassett Town an emphatic 5-1 derby victory over Highworth Town.

Thirteen years had passed since Bassett last tasted victory at The Elms, and this victory was made even sweeter as the three points lifted the team into eleventh, above Oxford City Nomads. And with five games – all at home – now remaining in this season, there's a great opportunity to ensure a record high finish in the Hellenic League Premier Division. Highworth, also have their eyes on a record, that being a place at Wembley in the FA Vase final. With the first leg of their semi-final on Saturday, it was therefore little surprise to see John Fisher field a rotated team. It was by no means weak though; the presence of 'keeper Gary Stevens and top scorer TJ Bohane, two of the main heroes of their superb Vase run, in the starting eleven attested to that. That selection may have been intended to frighten Bassett. But the visitors were in no way cowed and were on their game from the opening whistle.

With less than two minutes on the dock Bassett were ahead. James Skinner played a short free kick from the left wing to Dan Bailey and the midfielder struck a daisycutter from the edge of the area that Stevens got a hand to but failed to keep out. It should really have been two in the sixth minute when a blocked Callum Wright effort fell to Gambling, who had just the 'keeper to beat. But Stevens redeemed himself and parried away. In a rather frantic opening, Highworth – whose play was sharp in the final third – carved out two chances. The first saw Darren Smart arrow a low shot from twenty yards just wide of the left post before Bohane rose to head a Liam Edmondson cross onto the bar. Bassett quickly re-established authority though. Gambling was soon again denied at point blank range by Stevens as he flicked a shot towards goal following a driving run and cross from Dale Richards.

Then just before the half hour an expertly worked move doubled the lead. Steve Yeardley picked up possession on the right and burst inside before playing a pass into Gambling. With this back to goal, the forward steered a neat pass around the corner to strike partner Steve Robertson, who struck firmly into the bottom right corner. Again the advantage should have been extended further, but once more Stevens kept his side from being dead and buried before the break with a pair of saves at Robertson's feet. That meant that, although in a commanding position, Bassett were one wobble away from an uncomfortable half time team talk. They duly suffered one, their grievances with Olly Ballinger – who dished out five yellow cards to the visitors as half time approached – serving to distract them from the task in hand. And Highworth made their pressure count as James Skinner handled from a corner and Bohane sent Kurtis Sharkey the wrong way.

With a handful of players one misstep away from an early shower, it was imperative that Bassett refocused once the whistle to start the second half was blown. To their credit, they returned to the field sharp and determined to restore their two goal lead. In fact, a quick-fire double from Gambling made it 4-1 by the hour to effectively decide the outcome. His first came after a stunning, ruthless counter. Bassett broke decisively from a Highworth corner that failed to beat the first man. Yeardley clipped a diagonal ball for Skinner to race onto. He then threaded a pass through to Gambling, who buried beyond an exposed Gary Eggleton, a half time substitute.

Almost immediately from kick off Highworth conceded possession, and to compound matters for the hosts, Robertson was wrestled to the ground inside the box by Gareth Davies, who received his marching orders. From the spot Gambling coolly stroked home. With the extra man, Bassett pressed high against a Highworth

defence who were forced into frequently giving the ball away. Using this extra possession, the visitors stroked the ball around with further confidence, and numerous attacks could, and perhaps should, have made it five much earlier.

In the end it wasn't until the final kick of the game that Bassett made it a handful of goals for the evening as a poor touch from Eggleton when receiving a backpass was seized upon by Gambling and he completed his hat-trick by slotting in from a tight angle. Bassett – five games unbeaten in the league – are now rolling. The goal is now to keep that momentum going right until season's end.

Man of the Match: Nathan Gambling – the forward hassled the Highworth defence all night, took his three goals well and played a delightful measured pass to set up Steve Robertson. Were it not for some fine saves, he could have finished the night with more than just a hat-trick too.

Round-up Week 18 - Melksham Go Top As Leaders Are Beaten

Big game of the day saw the leaders Cricklade Town play host to last season's champions Wroughton. Cricklade were the form team in the division going into the game having won their previous five games. However, when the two sides had met at Wroughton earlier in the season it had finished 4-2 to Wroughton so the leaders knew they would be in for a tough game and so it proved. Leading scorer Devan Bryan put Cricklade in front with his 23rd of the season and it remained 1-0 at half time. In the second half Wroughton's leading scorer Shane Hibbert also got amongst the goals when he fired in the equaliser. Just as it looked like the points would be shared, up popped captain Chris Flanagan to score the winner for Wroughton, completing a league double over Cricklade in the process. The win meant Wroughton moved back above Shrewton United in the table and to within five points of Cricklade who dropped to second following the defeat.

The new leaders of the division are Melksham Town Reserves. In recent weeks the goals have dried up for Melksham with their last three games being decided by a single goal, including last week's 1-0 win over Corsham. On Saturday they well and truly re-found their shooting boots as they smashed eight past a Trowbridge side who are having a real tough period at the moment and are now without a win in ten games in all competitions. Earlier in the season Melksham had won 6-1 at Trowbridge and they went two goals better this time round in climbing back to the top of the table. Fielding a side which included a number of players from their successful Under 18 squad it was the youngsters who were amongst the goals, Seth Wain fired a hat-trick, Rhys Talmarsh scored twice, having also scored two in midweek for the Under 18's, and there were also goals for Zac Hillier, Dan Watts and Jake Sainsbury. The win lifted Melksham two points clear at the top of the table having played one game less than their nearest rivals. With Cricklade, Wroughton and Kintbury Rangers still to play at home Melksham are very much now in the title driving seat.

Bassett Bulldogs met Kintbury Rangers for the third time this season with Kintbury having won 7-0 in the league in September and 9-0 in the cup back in October, but Bassett Bulldogs came into the game on a high having defeated Trowbridge Town last week in what was probably the best result in their short history. They certainly built on that impressive win and gave Kintbury a real tough game this time round and held their high-flying opponents until the closing stages of the game. However, late goals from Tom Head and Lewis Sopp, the latter scoring on his debut, were enough to give Kintbury all three points. The win saw them moving to within a point of fourth placed Shrewton United but vitally with three games in hand on the three teams immediately above them and two in hand on leaders Melksham. They too will have an important say in the eventual destination of the title this season.

Westbury United Reserves and Bremhill fought out a 1-1 draw at Westbury, Ferris Lamrabet for the home side and Caine Bradbury with the Bremhill goal. The point meant Bremhill closed the gap to Bassett Bulldogs but remain at the foot of the table ahead of Tuesday's big Wiltshire Senior Cup quarter final against Bemerton Heath Harlequins from the Sydenham's Wessex League Premier Division. Best wishes to the league's sole surviving team in the FA's prestigious competition on Tuesday night.

The scheduled games at Corsham, Ludgershall, Purton and Shrewton were all postponed due to frozen pitches.






RWBTFC Attendances





THINK 'Magic of the Cup' for Non-League clubs and it's the FA Cup which naturally springs to mind.

And why wouldn't it? That once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for part-time clubs to pit their wits against professional outfits in front of big crowds and on the big stage. It's what clubs at our level live for.

Sadly, this year's FA Cup campaign proved something of a damp squib for Non-League clubs this year (Hereford, Woking and AFC Fylde aside), so with the Premier League big spenders left to battle it out for honours, our attentions can now turn to another proud national competition with equal prestige at stake.

This week, Step 4 minnows Hartley Wintney, Haringey Borough and Workington are preparing for, arguably, the biggest matches in their history when they play host to full-time National League outfits in the FA Trophy first round proper - just FOUR games away from gracing the biggest stage of them all at Wembley Stadium.

Similar in many respects to its most lucrative bigger brother, the FA Trophy has, for me, been in danger of losing a bit of prestige in the last 10-15 years. Statistics show that with five rounds to play on a Saturday and a two-legged semi-final to play before the final, the Trophy has often played second fiddle for the Conference big guns who have their eyes firmly fixed on the main prize of a place in the Football League.

This, coupled with the fact that many clubs don't include home FA Trophy ties as part of their season ticket package, has a drastic effect on attendance figures and therefore loses the competition credence when it comes to the business end of the season with crucial league places up for grabs.

Thankfully, however, those days are slowly coming to an end and clubs are beginning to take the FA Trophy seriously again. Just ask Hartley Wintney, Haringey Borough and Workington, who will be staging their own Wembley final next Saturday with the respective visits of Bromley, Leyton Orient and Hartlepool United to their humble abodes.

These three clubs - plus the other 61 in the hat for the first round next Saturday (16) - need only look back to May 21, 2017 when fans of York City and Macclesfield Town joined those of FA Vase finalists South Shields and Cleethorpes Town in a memorable Non-League Finals Day showcase under the arc, watched by a crowd of over 38,000.

For them, that's the magic of the cup, regardless of what competition it's

Second half turnaround seals victory

Second half goals from Steve Yeardley and Ryan Withers sealed a 2-1, come from behind victory for Royal Wootton Bassett Town against Woodley United.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town fought back from a 1-0 half time deficit to triumph 2-1 against Woodley United and seal an important, if scrappily earned, three points.

After two differing, yet equally chastening defeats in the past week, it was imperative for Rich Hunter's side to return to winning ways at home against a Woodley side who have had their difficulties adjusting to Hellenic League Premier Division football.

And they did so the hard way. Bassett's first half performance was a below-par one, and they deservedly trailed at the break, being fortunate not to be behind by more than Callum Samuel-Harman's 26th minute goal.

However, after the restart, Bassett's display was an accomplished one. Adapting their style of play to better take advantage of centre forward Lewis Waldon's gifts, they spent the period hammering away at the Woodley defence.

Ultimately, their resistance was broken as Steve Yeardley pounced to equalise with quarter of an hour to go. Substitute Ryan Withers then fired the home side in front three minutes later, with the youngster's well-taken goal proving to be the winner.

Playing with Haydon Richardson as a lone striker, Woodley had set themselves up to try and exploit Bassett on the break. But the visitors were to establish the upper hand. After Bassett wasted a free kick deep in opposition territory, Woodley quickly switched play to the other end of the field. A through ball was played to Englefield, who had been played onside, and he sought to slot in after rounding Lawrence, but Mason Hathaway was on hand to hack away off the line.

A similar counter soon delivered Woodley success. The direction of play was switched after an attempted cut back from Harvey Scholes was intercepted.
