

# Bassett News

### **Tonight's Game**

The relentless schedule of games continues as we tonight play our 14<sup>th</sup> game of the season in just 45 days, almost a game every three days. Each and every game has been really tough this season and I am sure Sam and his team could do with a break and have some time back on the training pitch but he will have to wait a week for that (assuming the league do not insert any more fixtures between now and then).

Tonight we welcome a familiar set of faces to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground in Lydney Town for the third meeting of the season between the two teams, the sides having met in the FA Cup already. The first game between the two teams finishing 0-0 before an eight-goal thriller in the replay at Lydney which did not lack for controversy as well as some superb goals and a lesson in finishing from the visitors Ross Gabriel.

A warm welcome to our visitors from Lydney Town who have made the journey for this evening's encounter. We hope they enjoy their second visit of the season to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground and we wish them a safe journey back either across the bridge or around Gloucester if avoiding the bridge toll.

### Bashley

Our interest in this season's FA Vase was short and sweet. Having received a bye in the First Qualifying Round due to the demise of Oxford City Nomads we met a very good Bashley side in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Qualifying Round on Saturday and were on the wrong end of a 4-0 score line. For me Bashley were probably the best side we have played in a long time and I include pre-season friendlies against Swindon Supermarine and last season's games against Thatcham Town, Bracknell Town and Highworth Town last season in that analysis. As Virginia Water had done to us the previous Tuesday, Bashley gave us very little time on the ball as they shut us down and also doubled-up on Josh Shama preventing him being able to get around their defence. No surprise to discover that they had apparently watched out game at Virginia Water but even without that planning they were clearly a very good side and one that looks like they will be returning to the higher echelons of the Non-league Pyramid that they previously occupied. On Saturday we gave the ball away far too much in the first half and were 3-0 down at the break but an improved second half which saw us conceded just one more and create a couple of chances of our own gives us something to take into tonight's game.

It will be another tough game here tonight with Lydney possessing two of the best strikers in the league in Ross Gabriel and our former player Lewis Thompson but hopefully we can put the recent defeats behind us and return to winning ways here tonight.

### **Development Side**

The Development side suffered another agonising single goal defeat on Saturday against former Hellenic League side Trowbridge Town. This is the four game of the season where the Development team have lost by one goal We led 1-0 courtesy of a Josh Bolton goal but then conceded a soft goal to let Trowbridge back into the game. We then had a couple of glorious chances to get back in front but failed to net and were made to pay when the home side netted the winner four minutes from time.

### Sunday Side

The Sunday side maintained their 100% record with a hard fought 3-2 home win over Penhill United. The win was secured in the opening period when two goals from Jack Duckers and one from Lewis Petrie gave Bassett a 3-0 lead at half time. It could have been more, but Marcus Hall missed a penalty for Bassett. Second half was a different story as Penhill, with the strong wind behind them came back at Bassett. They pulled back two goals and it could have been more but for two blinding saves from Dave Groom which kept Bassett's lead intact. A real scare at the end when Penhill lobbed the Bassett keeper only for the ball to somehow bounce over the bar to deny the visitors an equaliser. The win left Danny Groom's side in second place behind Greyhound on goal difference.

### **Premier Division**





# Our Visitors This Season



Lydney opened their league programme with a win over Longlevens. Their scheduled opening day trip to Brackley Town Saints was postponed when their mini-bus broke down but when they then saw some action in midweek they had a fine 3-2 away win at Longlevens.

This was followed by a 2-1 defeat of Combined Counties League side AFC Hayes 2-1. Amongst the scorers for Lydney that day was former Royal Wootton Bassett Town player Lewis Thompson who made 20 appearances for us, scoring 4 times, in Season 2016-17 whilst on loan from Swindon Supermarine. No doubt Lewis will be keen to do well against his former teammates here today and the defence will know what a handful he can be.

After the FA Cup game, they picked up a useful point in a 2-2 draw against Brimscombe & Thrupp, one of the fancied sides this season.

They suffered their first defeat of the season when they lost 4-1 away at a rejuvenated Ascot United. At the time it looked a bad result but with Ascot currently leading the table with just two defeats in their opening 10 games with hindsight it does not look so bad.

They once again played Longlevens, as part of the Hellenic fixture scheduling double-headers this season, this time at home and a hat-trick from Ross Gabriel put them three nil up. Longlevens scored twice but were unable to find an equaliser meaning a repeat of the result earlier in the season.

Next up was our FA Cup 0-0 draw which was followed by another 0-0 in the league in the Bank Holiday Monday home fixture with Tuffley Rovers.

Lydney made a quick exit from the FA Vase when, minus six players, they went down 3-1 at home to Combined Counties side Abbey Rangers.

They bounced back in midweek when all the missing players returned, unfortunately for us it was the FA Cup replay against Bassett. A hat-trick from Ross Gabriel plus one for Lewis Thompson in the 5-3 win saw Lydney through to the next round. This gave Lydney a 1<sup>st</sup> Qualifying Round tie against Lymington from the Wessex League and a late equaliser in a 2-2 draw meant another replay. This time Lydney were unable to defeat their opponents on home soil, Lymington winning the replay 2-1.

On Saturday Lydney Town became the first side to defeat Wantage Town in the league this season, a solitary strike from Ross Gabriel giving them the points. The win lifted Lydney into 10<sup>th</sup> place in the table two points behind us but with three games in hand.

# Visitors - Tourist Information

### Introduction to Lydney

Lydney is a small town in the county of Gloucestershire. It is on the west bank of the River Severn, in the Forest of Dean and is 16 miles (25 km) southwest of Gloucester as the crow flies. The town has been bypassed since 1995 by the A48 road.

### **Interesting Facts About Lydney**

The ships that opposed the Spanish Armada in the 16th century were built around Lydney using the great oaks that could be found in the area

In 1810, docks were constructed to capitalise on the town's location, close to the River Severn. The River Lyd flows through the town and into the River Severn.

In 1879 a magnificent rail bridge was built across the Severn at Lydney by the Severn Bridge Railway Company. At 4,162 feet long and comprising of 21 spans it crossed over to the canal just above Sharpness on the east bank of the river. It enabled a huge amount of trade to pass between the Forest and the rest of the country and was seen as a great success. Its downfall came in 1960 when a large tanker barge went adrift on the river and was swept downstream on to the infamous surge, hitting and demolishing a pillar and two spans. The bridge lay derelict for nine years and was finally dismantled to avoid it being any further hazard to shipping.

JRR Tolkien's "Lord of the Rings' books are thought to have been inspired by the earthworks and ruins at , Lydney Park Estate which can still be seen today.

On 31 August 1962, the Beatles played at Lydney Town Hall.

### **Famous Residents**

Former Glamorgan and England cricketer Steve James was born in Lydney and started his cricket career playing for the local club. Lydney was also the first English club of England wicket-keeper Geraint Jones. The Rugby referee Wayne Barnes is an alumni of Lydney's school The Dean Academy. The TV presenter Lisa Rogers who was a panellist on Loose Women and a number of other shows such as Never Mind the Buzzcocks and Shooting Stars was born in Lydney, although now lives in Wales.

### **Nearest railway station**

The nearest railway station is actually just outside Lydney. It is located on the Gloucester-Newport line. The station is located a mile south of Lydney, and was originally called Lydney Junction, which is now the name of the nearby station on the preserved Dean Forest Railway.

### **Nearest Pubs to Ground**

To the west and on the other side of Bathurst Park is the Cross Keys Inn (pictured) whilst the Greyhound Inn is to the North East of the ground



### Things to Do in Lydney

Adjacent to the Football ground is Bathurst Park, a beautifully maintained and large green area. The Park has a very nice cafe with a good selection of snacks. There is a large fish pond at one end with a lot of goldfish and carp and some beautiful flower gardens. Well worth a visit on the day of a match.

A little further afield, Dean Forest Railway is a heritage railway running through the Forest of Dean run by volunteers. It has 5 stations along its line - with great walks and local pubs accessible from many. The southern terminus is at Lydney Junction and is only a 2 minute walk from the mainline Lydney station.

Another place of interest is the historic Lydney Harbour which from Roman times through the industrial revolution and well into the 20th century has been a cornerstone of the River Severn's heritage. The Severn Estuary is known the world over for its massive tidal range and internationally important habitat, but even more so for its history of exporting and as one of the UK's principle sea links to the rest of the world. Lydney Harbour has played a full part in making the Severn Estuary the gateway from the South West to the rest of the world. There is a very pleasant and easy walk around the docks and harbour.

# Player Profile

### **Adam Corcoran (Defender)**



Corcoran is a talented, imposing defender, with the ability of playing either at centre half or full back, who re-joined Bassett for a second spell in the summer of 2015.

Composed on the ball and dominant in the air, Corcoran is a Cirencester Town Academy graduate and featured in the team that made it to the third round of the 2008-09 FA Youth Cup where they were narrowly defeated by Sunderland. That season he would also

make four appearances for the Cirencester Town first team in Southern League Division One South & West. He would play one game for the Centurions a season later before beginning the 2010-11 campaign with Hellenic Premier Division Fairford Town. The defender made nine appearances, scoring one goal in a 2-2 draw with Shrivenham for the Cinder Lane outfit, before transferring to Western League side Calne Town. And Corcoran established himself as a first team regular for Jeff Roberts' team, appearing 16 times, 15 of which were starts.

He spent the entire 2011-12 campaign with Bassett, making his debut on the opening day at centre back away against Malmesbury Victoria. He appeared 28 times, scoring once that season before again playing a key role in Bassett's 2012-13 promotion campaign, playing 34 times and grabbing one goal. While manager Dave Turner moved on following that season. Corcoran staved with Bassett and new manager Jeff Roberts, featuring 40 times. primarily at full back, and netting five goals. He then switched to Shrivenham in 2014, making 33 appearances.

Corcoran returned to Bassett the following season and played 32 times. Two seasons ago the defender saw his number of appearances limited as he played 18 times, scoring a single goal in a Floodlit Cup thrashing of Sandhurst Town. Meanwhile, last season he featured on 24 occasions, netting twice.

Despite his defensive qualities, Corcoran can also be a threat going forward and can strike a ball finely as evidenced by his lone goal in his first season with Bassett - a stunning left footed curler against Pewsey Vale in the Wiltshire Senior Cup - and the brace he scored against Abingdon United in 2013-14.



### Royal Wootton Bassett Town FC • Club History

Situated six miles from Swindon, Royal Wootton Bassett Town Football Club was first established in 1882, making the club one of the oldest in Wiltshire. The club's early achievements came in the Wiltshire Senior Cup, making the final in both 1902-3 and 1903-4, although losing both. The club folded for a period pre-World War 1 before re-forming in the Calne & District League when it began playing at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground which had been donated by a local dignitary for sporting activities within the town and opened in 1930.



Early successes included winning the Calne & District League in the 1930-31 Season, having finished runners-up the previous season, and then again in 1934-35. Following a move up to the Wiltshire League Division 2 promotion was earned again the following season and the team then remained in the top division in the county until the outbreak of war.

After the war Wootton Bassett Town F.C. recommenced in the County League with limited success until 1958-59 when they won their first Wiltshire League title. In 1987-88 the Wiltshire League Division 1 title was won, elevating the club into the Hellenic League, where they have remained ever since. The club finally won the Wiltshire Senior Cup in 1998-99 and repeated this achievement in 2000-01. The club have had three spells in the Hellenic Premier and gained promotion back in 2012-13.

Since the onset of the new millennium the club has expanded significantly, with the establishment of a thriving Youth Section, Ladies Section, Veterans team and Sunday side. The club now operates 27 teams from under 7s upwards. All play their games at the relocated Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, which opened in the summer of 2015. This growth led to the club being awarded Charter Standard Development Club status by the Football Association in 2008 before this was upgraded to Community Club status a year later. Wootton Bassett Town FC was the first club in Wiltshire to achieve this. International ties have also been established with Dutch amateur side FC 's-Gravenzande.

Season 2018-19 sees Sam Collier in charge of the First Team.

### Bassett receive a Vase Bash-ing

Royal Wootton Bassett Town have rarely fared well when paired with Wessex League opposition in national competitions. And that trend continued as Bassett were well beaten by Bashley in their FA Vase second qualifying round tie.

The Hampshire visitors were in control throughout, racing to a 3-0 half time lead before ultimately triumphing 4-0.

To compound matters for the hosts, they were unable to muster a consolation goal, Brad Pagliaroli coming closest when his firmly struck shot from the edge of the area forced a good save from Collins.

# Our Visitors History

### **Lydney Town FC • Club History**

Although Lydney is one of the main towns of the Forest area the Severnsiders have always led a very nomadic existence. With the town very much a Rugby stronghold the football club has always found it difficult to exist and although the club can trace its roots back to 1911 it never has had a sound base. The club competed in the local leagues until 1952 when they were elected to the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League. In 1969 the club folded due to lack of committee. In 1971 the soccer lovers of the town pulled together and the club re-formed and in 1974 the appointment of Harold Elliott as player/coach saw many players from Lydney Juniors introduced with the resulting effect of promotion to Senior League Division One in 1976. During this period the club switched from Bathurst Park onto the Recreation Ground using the changing facilities at the Cricket Club.

In 1979-80 after twice finishing Runners-Up they finally lifted the Senior League Division One Championship. Applications to the County League were unfruitful so the club turned to the Hellenic League, where the club held its own, but after 4 seasons the huge financial burden of the League forced the club to return to the Senior League. A dispute with the Cricket Club saw the club move back onto Bathurst Park and following this Secretary Roger Sansom, who had been elected in 1975 and who is still secretary to this day, investigated the possibility of building a clubhouse on the Recreation Ground. Unfortunately on the pitch the downward spiral continued and the club found itself back in the NGL. The players thankfully stayed together and they bounced back into the Senior League the following season. Ambitious plans to have our own clubhouse were still in the pipeline and a clubhouse was opened on Lydney Recreation Trust in 1990. In 1995 the club did the double by winning Division Two and the Forest Green Supporters Trophy, a feat they repeated in 1996-97.

In 2003-04 Manager Peter Elliott, who along with Roger Sansom are the longest serving members of the club with 40 plus years service, guided the club to the Final of the League Cup and the Senior Amateur Cup but in 2004 due to work commitments Peter decided to step down. The club turned to Stuart Liddington to take the helm and with Peter being persuaded to assist him they forged a very successful partnership. The addition of Pete Macklin from Cinderford Town, Danny Clarke ex-Oxford United, Matthew Timmins from Whitecroft and the return of Mark Saunders from Australia gave the club a real boost. Pete, Danny and 'Matty' provided the missing link in the goalscoring department scoring over 70 goals between them, Danny leading the way with 32 goals. The Senior League title was secured with 4 games to go and they did the double by lifting the Senior Amateur Cup. The season was complete with the news of acceptance into the County League a prize denied to them some 25 years ago. The clubs County League campaign started in unconvincing fashion with only 4 points from 3 home games but a 20 game unbeaten run saw the club take over as league leaders at the start of 2006, a position they held for the remainder of the season. Scoring goals was very much the key to winning as 87 goals proved, 'Matty' Timmins finishing the leagues leading goal scorer with 28 goals. This success was beyond the clubs wildest dreams and gave the club the opportunity of a return to the Hellenic League after 22 years. A steady start saw the club 12 points behind the leaders in October but a 6 game winning streak at the end of the year saw the club take over as leaders at the start of January. The critical game came in mid-April with fellow title contenders Trowbridge Town visiting 'The Rec'. In front of a crowd of 305 goals from Danny Clarke and Mark Crabbe secured victory and a 5 point cushion. With 3 games to go the Title was won at Malmesbury when Danny Bishop came off the subs bench to score 2 late goals and give the club an unprecedented 3rd title in as many seasons. The squad had certainly exceeded all expectations and can guite easily be classed as the best in the clubs history. Ambitious plans for the required improvements to gain promotion were put forward and accepted by the League allowing the club to play at the highest level in its history.

A steady start was overshadowed by events off the pitch when despite gaining planning permission for erection of floodlights the club became embroiled in a sea of red tape with their landlords. To continue playing in the Premier Division an agreement was reached to use Cinderford Town and Harrow Hill for home games. Despite these off the pitch issues an unbeaten league run of 11 games placed them in the top half of the table. Despite finishing in 10th position the club were unable to satisfy the April deadline imposed by the league and were forced to be relegated back into Division One (West).

With relegation came the inevitable loss of players who wished to play at a higher level of football and the club decided to pin its future hopes on the youth of the town. Mark Lee, who joined the club 8 years ago from County League side Ellwood, took on the role of Player/Manager and despite a tough baptism over the last he is 6th year in charge. The club finished runners-up to Tytherington Rocks in 2014-15 but despite finishing in a promotion position ground development had not been completed by the March 31st deadline and a further season in Division One followed.

Determined that such a situation would not happen again further development work followed to ensure the necessary G grading but disappointingly after all the clubs efforts the club finished in third spot which would not necessarily ensure promotion. As luck would have it circumstances led to the club being offered a place in the Premier Division which they readily accepted but this again meant further development was needed to obtain an F Grading and this was attained in 2016 with the installation of a 2nd stand. On the field a respectable 12th place in 2015-16 was improved upon in 2016-17 with a 9th place finish with the highlight of the season coming with the lifting of the Floodlit Trophy beating Flackwell Heath on penalties after the game finished 3-3.





# From The development Side

### 15th September 2018

The last 100% record went as the reigning league champions were brought back down to earth by a rampant Wroughton side who ran out 5-1 winners maintaining the record of being one of two clubs in the league never to lose to Kintbury Rangers. Trowbridge had trailed at the break to a Josh Bolton goal for Royal Wootton Bassett Town who also had a couple of good chances in the second half that were missed. Trowbridge's first came from a deflected free kick and the winner came four minutes from time with a powerful shot into the top corner of the net. That is now four games unbeaten for Trowbridge with the win lifting them two places in the table into 6<sup>th</sup> place. For Royal Wootton Bassett Town Development that is now four single goal defeats in their opening seven games as they dropped down to 12<sup>th</sup> place in the table.

Purton secured their second win of the season in a close affair at the Red House against Marlborough Town. A brace from leading scorer William Backhouse and one from Nathan Marland had put Purton 3-1 up at half time and despite a much improved second half performance from the visitors Marlborough they could only score once more, and Purton ran out 3-2 winners. Scorers for Marlborough were Aaron Presley and Jordan Ball.

The game between Cricklade Town and Malmesbury Victoria Development was postponed due to a lack of match officials caused by the day's FA Vase games in the county.

Saturday 17th October 1987 Wootton Bassett Town 3 Sanford 1 Headline: Troubled by youthful side

Damon York justified his recall to the Bassett side on Saturday with two second half goals enabling them to record another victory.

The scoreline suggests a relatively comfortable victory for Bassett, but in truth it was a game in which they failed to play their best football, and they were often troubled by the youthful and strong running Sanford side.

Bassett started the game very positively and for the first 20 minutes played some delightful football culminating in a well taken goal from Frost.

Other chances came but none were taken and as Bassett drifted out of the game so Sanford came into it, making the most of the space they were allowed.

However, despite applying pressure Sanford had not looked like scoring until VInes stumbled and handled the ball in the box. Casey converted the penalty for Sanford and they would have taken the lead five minutes later had Rees not pulled off a marvellous save at the feet of the Sanford centre-forward.

The second half saw Bassett deny Sanford the space they had been allowed in the first and start to regain control of the midfield.

Following a period of pressure York's first goal came after 65 minutes. Receiving the ball on the edge of the box he bundled his way past two challenges before sliding the ball past the keeper.

Bassett were now in control but didn't make the game safe until seven minutes from the end when a short free kick on the right was passed to York who left two defenders standing before firing a low hard shot into the far corner.







